Definitions & Tutorial

Column Definitions

- **ID Number:** This is a unique identifier assigned to each opportunity by the foundation relations team. Please reference this number when reaching out to the team to avoid confusion between similar opportunities.
- **Deadline:** The deadline for the application, potentially based on the previous cycle (please see Deadline Status below). Note, if blank, this indicates that the opportunity is rolling.
- **Deadline Type:** This column indicates what type of application the foundation will require, generally a Letter of Intent or a Full Proposal. Note that a Full Proposal is typically more involved than a Letter of Intent and might require more time for preparation/
- **Deadline Status:** This column indicates whether the grant opportunity is confirmed, rolling, or anticipated. If anticipated, the grant is not currently open for application and all the details will be based on the previous year or cycle of the grant opportunity.
- **Sponsor:** The foundation or foundations supporting the grant opportunity.
- **Opportunity Name:** The specific name of the grant opportunity, hyperlinked to the foundation website.
- **Maximum Amount:** The maximum amount available for this grant opportunity. This number is often indicated directly by the foundation, but in some cases is an estimate based on previous grant cycles. Please see the funding opportunity announcement for complete details. For opportunities that do not specify exact amounts of where a wide range of grant amounts is possible, this column may be empty.

NOTE: Many of these unspecified opportunities are for larger amounts (for example, for support for clinical trials). If filtering by this column, please use “Where Maximum Amount is empty” OR “Maximum amount is greater/less than *your ideal amount*” in your filter terms. See tutorials below for more information on filtering.
- **Maximum Duration:** The maximum duration of the grant. When a maximum duration is not specified, we have marked it as "Not Indicated." Please include this term in your filtering to ensure these opportunities are not filtered out.
- **Description:** A brief description of the grant opportunity, taken directly from the foundation website.
- **Career Level:** The career level or levels of principal investigators eligible to apply for the grant. This column includes opportunities for graduate students (“Graduate Student” or “Medical Student”), post-doctoral fellows and residency fellows (“Post-Doc” or “Medical Resident”) and for researchers who are “Early,” “Middle,” or “Established” in their careers. Please check the specific opportunity’s eligibility requirements (in the next column) for their precise definitions of these terms, as they can vary among funders.
- **Eligibility Requirements:** This column includes eligibility requirements for applicants, as set out by the funder.

- **URL:** This column includes a hyperlink to the grant opportunity.
- **Tags:** Multiple keywords for each opportunity, such as “Arts” and “Anthropology” or “Oncology” and “Cardiology.” If filtering by this opportunity, make sure to use “has any of.”
- **Project/Award Type:** This column indicates the type of work that is most appropriate for this grant opportunity. This can include Program, Research, Teaching, Career Development, Product/Drug Development, Fellowship, or Clinical Trials.
- **Limited Submission:** This column indicates opportunities where the university can only submit a limited number of applications. If you are interested in these opportunities, please reach out to the Office of Foundation Relations (foundationrelations@miami.edu) or the Office of the Vice Provost for Research and Scholarship (vprs@miami.edu) for more information about the internal limited submission process.

Description

The Damon Runyon Clinical Investigator Award supports independent young physician-scientists conducting disease-oriented research that demonstrates a high level of innovation and creativity. The goal is to support the best young physician-scientists doing work aimed at improving the practice of cancer medicine.

The Clinical Investigator Award responds to three recognized realities:

- Though there has never been a more pressing need or more promising time for clinical cancer research, fewer young physicians enter this area of investigation every year.
- The number of institutions committed to training young physicians in the scientific discipline and methodologies of clinical investigation is critically low.
- The burden of medical school debt (averaging over \$100,000) discourages many physicians from pursuing clinical investigation.


