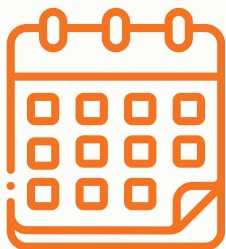


GRANT SEEKING WORKSHOP SERIES
